- Don't do any burning during a burn ban. Check with your local fire officials on status of bans. Violation is punishable by law.
 - Be sure your address is clearly visible from the road.
 - Create a space at least 30 feet around your home and storage buildings from debris and keep grass mowed
 - Store wood piles at least 30 feet away from your home
 - Don't park vehicles (including farm equipment) in dry grass.
 - Clear under electric fences and around any heat source (propane tanks).
 - Store Flammable liquids properly. Keep them away from heat sources and never store inside your house.
 - Post the phone number for the Poison Control Center.
 - Use your BBQ grill over cement or dirt, and be sure when finished using the grill that your coals are out. (Douse them with water)
 - Establish firebreaks along your property. (Fences, roadways, fields)
 - When welding or using tools that produce sparks make sure your work area is free of grass and debris, and have a water source near by.
