



We are excited to have **YOU** as a patron of the Canyon Area Library. Our staff is eager to assist you with any questions you may have. Our phone number is (806)655-5015. Here is some information about our Library and some of the services we offer:

**LIBRARY HOURS:**

- Monday - Thursday 10am-7pm
- Friday 10am-5:30pm
- Saturday 10am-2pm
- Sunday CLOSED

- Checkout periods are two weeks for books and one week for DVD's and magazines. There is a limit of 5 DVD's per library card.
- A wealth of information can be found on our website at [www.canyonlibrary.org](http://www.canyonlibrary.org). You may renew your books by going to "My Account", which is a green circle located mid-page. You can check our card catalog to search for a book or find our monthly calendar for upcoming Library events such as Storytime, Knit Night, Book Club, Munchkins in Motion, Summer Reading program, Family Place, and other free events. Public Wi-Fi is available and no password is required. To use our computers, log in as a Patron and enter your 13 digit Library card number and four digit pin. Copies from the computers are printed at the front desk and are 15¢ for a one sided copy and 30¢ for a two sided copy. Only cash is accepted.
- Please take advantage of Library Elf by signing up by e-mail at [www.libraryelf.com](http://www.libraryelf.com). Once you are registered you will receive e-mails or text alerts when your Library items are coming due. A drop box is located on the north side off of the alley for book returns and is open 24/7. Our Library does not charge late fees for overdue books, but your account is blocked from additional check outs or database usage until the books are returned or renewed. The no-fine policy does not apply to lost or damaged items.

- We have two reading apps available for your device: Cloud Library  and HOOPLA . You can find these in the app store for your device. You can use Hoopla for 5 checkouts per month and Cloud Library for unlimited monthly checkouts.
- Large print and new books are located along the north wall of the Library. We also have special areas dedicated to our young and juvenile age groups: Lego Canyon for juvenile readers and for our young readers there is an area in the southwest corner where a tri-wing table is supplied with many interactive games, puzzles, and hands-on toys. We also have two computers in the children's area for their fun and learning.
- The Canyon Area Library is pleased to offer the  55 by 5 program for our birth to age 5 patrons designed to encourage early reading literacy. Fifty books are divided into 5 backpacks with 10 books in each pack. Once the child completes all five backpacks and five developmental activities they will complete the  55 by 5 project. If interested, sign up is available at the front desk.
- Please note: Your Library card needs to be renewed annually in person with your driver's license. If your driver's license does not have your current Canyon address, additional proof of residency will be required.
